





## **Disposal Guidelines for Asbestos**

- 1. Submit copy of State License and insurance certificate prior to disposal event.
- 2. Georgia EPD GEOS 14-day Asbestos Project Notification submittal number must be provided prior to disposal event.
- 3. Provide Waste Shipment Record (WSR) for all loads.
- 4. All material for disposal must be packaged as recommended by Georgia EPD and EPA.
- 5. Material <u>must</u> be unloaded by hand if friable. If material is non-friable, material can be unloaded by hand or handled per Georgia EPD's "Recommended Procedures for Bulk Handling of Non-Friable Asbestos Containing Waste Material".
- 6. All workers unloading asbestos must wear the proper personal protective equipment (clothing and respirator).
- 7. Workers must be supervised while unloading.
- 8. Extra packaging material (plastic bags, tape and labels) must be available to repackage asbestos if necessary.
- 9. Disposal must be <u>scheduled</u> between the hours of 10:00 AM and 2:00 PM, Monday through Friday. At least 24 hours prior notice is required.
- 10. Disposal fees are \$44.00 per ton <u>and</u> \$250.00 per disposal event for waste handling. (Note the \$250.00 per disposal event charge for waste handling must be paid via a separate check at the time of disposal.)
- 11. Payment is required at the time of disposal, unless other arrangements are made prior to disposal. Contact our office regarding credit.
